

**ANCSA 17(b) Public Easements**



**Easement Details**

Pursuant to Sec. 17(b) of the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act of December 18, 1971, 43 U.S.C. 3 1616(b) (1976), the following public easements are reserved to the United States. All easements are subject to applicable Federal, State, or Municipal corporation regulation. The following is a listing of the uses allowed on each type of easement. Any uses which are not specifically listed are prohibited.

**25-foot Trail**  
 The uses allowed on a twenty-five (25) foot wide trail easement are: Travel by foot, dog-sled, animals, snowmobiles, two- and three-wheeled vehicles, small all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) (less than 3,000 lbs. Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW)).

**50-foot Trail**  
 The uses allowed on a fifty (50) foot wide trail easement are: Travel by foot, dog-sled, animals, snowmobiles, two- and three-wheeled vehicles, small all-terrain vehicles (ATVs), tracked vehicles, and four-wheel drive vehicles.

**60-foot Road**  
 The uses allowed on a sixty (60) foot wide road easement are: Travel by foot, dog-sled, animals, snowmobiles, two- and three-wheeled vehicles, small all-terrain vehicles, tracked vehicles, four-wheel-drive vehicles, automobiles, and trucks.

**One-acre Site**  
 The uses allowed on a one (1) acre site easement are: Vehicle parking (e.g., aircraft, boats, all terrain vehicles (ATVs), snowmobiles, cars, trucks), temporary camping, and loading or unloading. Temporary camping, loading, and unloading shall be limited to 24 hours.

**EIN 2 CS**  
 An easement for a proposed access trail 25 feet in width from public land in Section 36, T16N R17E, Copper River Meridian, southerly through Section 1, T15N R17E, Copper River Meridian, to public land in Section 6, T15N R18E, Copper River Meridian. The allowed uses are those listed above for a 25-foot trail.

**EIN 19 CS M**  
 A 1-acre site easement upland of the ordinary high water mark in Section 9, T14N R19E, Copper River Meridian, on the right bank of the Chisana River. The allowed uses are those listed above for a 1-acre site.

**EIN 27 C3 CS D9**  
 An easement for an existing access trail 50 feet in width from the Northway Airport in Section 25, T14N R18E, Copper River Meridian, southerly to public land in Section 2, T15N R18E, Copper River Meridian. The allowed uses are those listed above for a 50-foot wide trail.

**EIN 39 C3 CS D1**  
 An easement for an existing road 60 feet in width from the Alaska Highway in Section 30, T13N R20E, Copper River Meridian, westerly to public land at Deadman Lake in Section 24, T13N R20E, Copper River Meridian. The allowed uses are those listed above for a 60-foot wide road.

**EIN 46 I**  
 An easement for an existing road 60 feet in width from the Northway Airport in Section 25, T14N R18E, Copper River Meridian, southerly to the FAA TACAN site in Section 36, T14N R18E, Copper River Meridian. The allowed uses are those listed above for a 60-foot wide road. Use of this easement is limited to the U.S. Government, its agents, or assignees.

**EIN 52 C4 CS E**  
 An easement for a proposed access trail 50 feet in width from Section 31, T13N R18E, Copper River Meridian, westerly to public land in Section 1, T12N R17E, Copper River Meridian. The allowed uses are those listed above for a 50-foot wide trail.

**EIN 55 CS D1**  
 An easement for an existing road 50 feet in width from the Alaska Highway in Section 14, T16N R17E, Copper River Meridian, southerly to the right bank of the Tanana River in Section 24, T16N R17E, Copper River Meridian. The allowed uses are those listed above for a 60-foot wide road.

**EIN 55 CS D1**  
 A 1-acre site easement upland of the ordinary high water mark in Section 24, T16N R17E, Copper River Meridian, on the right bank of the Tanana River. The allowed uses are those listed above for a 1-acre site.

**EIN 103 I**  
 An easement restricting the use of the land within a 2,000 foot radius of the VOR antenna located in Section 36, T14N R18E, Copper River Meridian. The uses allowed include those associated with the construction, operation, and maintenance of a VORTAC site, the right to keep the land clear from any obstruction infringing upon or penetrating the airspace, and the right to prohibit use on and remove from the land beneath the airspace any source which would create interference for the users of the VORTAC site.

**EIN 104 C4**  
 An easement for an existing road 60 feet in width from the Northway Airport-Nabesna Village Road in Section 26, T14N R18E, Copper River Meridian, northeasterly to the FAA Range site. The allowed uses are those listed above for a 60-foot wide road.

**EIN 105 C6 D1 D9**  
 An easement for an existing and proposed access trail 25 feet in width from the Alaska Highway in Section 4, T16N R17E, Copper River Meridian, southerly to public land in Section 8, T16N R17E, Copper River Meridian. The allowed uses are limited to travel by foot, dog-sled, animals, and snowmobiles.

These easements are not to be used for access to private land without the prior permission of the landholder.

Some easements shown on this map are not marked on the ground with any type of sign, visible trail, or other locational aids. It is the visitor's responsibility to ascertain and maintain their correct position within the easement corridor. Visitors are strongly encouraged to obtain and use a GPS device.
